Deltas are amongst the most environmentally and economically important coastal  
sedimentary environments. Studies of deltas lag behind research in both fluvial  
and deep-water depositional systems, as well as more geomorphologically oriented  
land studies. This knowledge lag reflects both a reorientation of the the petroleum  
industry in the last two decades toward deep-water systems, as well as the  
difficulty of working across the shoreline with the traditional tools used for  
oceanographic or land-based work. However, deltaic studies are experiencing a  
renewed focus, because of their global importance in environmental and other  
societal concerns. This volume stems from a special session, "Deltas: Old and  
New," held at the Annual Geological Society of America conference in October  
2002, that was convened to highlight these new directions in deltaic

Corruption, crime, economic inequality, religious fundamentalism, financial crises, environmental degradation, population ageing, gender inequality, large-scale migration This book tackles many of the most pressing problems facing societies today. The authors demonstrate that similar social mechanisms lie behind many of these seemingly disparate problems. Indeed, many societal problems can be traced back to behaviours that are perfectly rational and often well-intended from an individual perspective. Yet, taken together these behaviours can – paradoxically – give rise to unintended and undesirable outcomes at the society level. In addition to addressing the causes of societal problems, the book explains why some problems rank higher on the public agenda than others. Employing a

Throughout the book, students are introduced to analytical concepts such as free-riding, herding behaviour, principal-agent relations and moral hazard. These concepts are essential tools for better understanding the roots of many societal problems that regularly make headlines in the news. This improved understanding will, in turn, be critical for ultimately finding solutions to these problems.
