The term occupational therapy (OT) is defined in IDEA at §300.34(c)(6) as follows: (6) Occupational therapy — (i) Means services provided by a qualified occupational therapist; and (ii) Includes— (A) Improving, developing, or restoring functions impaired or lost through illness, injury, or deprivation;
